## Barbells in the basement

Have you ever wanted to work out in the catacombs of an 85-year-old building?

Move to Silo Point and you'll have access to the 5,000-square-foot Life FX fitness center opening in the basement of the one-time Locust Point grain elevator.

The space once housed large equipment and was used to move grain onto the building's adjoining piers.

Gym-goers will be surrounded by cement pillars every eight to 11 feet. Membership to the gym, slated to open in January, is only available to Silo Point residents. The gym is owned by Hunt Valley's FX Studios.

The 24-story tower was redeveloped by Baltimore's Turner Development Group and had its grand opening Oct. 23.

The more than 200 condominiums range from \$260,000 to \$4 million and feature views of the city's skyline.
